Agreed statement from Mr Chris Ward and Ms Rosalind Squire

We agree that the following performance measures of the levels of service:

- 85% of properties zoned residential:
- Within 500m of open space; and
- 4ha/1,000 head of population.

are open to interpretation.

We agree that the performance measure in in Mr Chris Ward's evidence takes 500m from all open space.

We agree that the performance measure Ms Rosalind Squire's evidence takes 500m from all neighbourhood recreation reserves (i.e. does not include walkways or utility reserves – storm water detention areas).

We agree that in the case of the 500 m LOS you could read it as the crow flies or walking distance from a residential property. Literal interpretation for simplicity vs more nuanced.

We agree that in the case of the 4ha/1,000 head of population we note that the figure can be skewed by larger reserves in peri-urban areas i.e. Moturoa/Rabbit Island and Aniseed Valley Reserves. But we both agree that this LOS measure is met.

We agree that the provision of additional facilities over and above planting/trees on a reserve should and would be subject to consultation with the nearby community.

We agree that some of the gaps have been created by pre-existing residential subdivision not providing reserves.
