

Section 91 – Mandatory Measures in Code Extreme Fire Danger - Version 4, 15 February 2019

All residential property owners and occupiers must follow mandatory measures as detailed in the below table

Any commercial operators operating as a PCBU under the Health and Safety in Work Act 2015 must use the following existing industry protocols for extreme fire risk status may apply for an exemption

These protocols include:

- Nelson/Marlborough Forest Industry Working Group, Fire Prevention Guidelines for Forestry Operations (Updated 13th June 2017)
- Nelson Tasman Fire Prevention Guideline for Heat and Spark Hazardous Activities/ Hotwork
