DECISION

This is an application by The Grind Coffee Roasters Limited for a Temporary Authority Order in respect of premises situated at 387 Aporo Road, Ruby Bay-Tasman, known as "The Tasman General Store".

Reports were received from the Licensing Inspector and the Police and no matters in opposition were raised. Accordingly we deal with the matter on the papers.

We are satisfied as to the matters to which we must have regard as set out in Section 136 of the Act.

Accordingly we grant an Order authorising the sale and supply of alcohol from the premises situated at **387 Aporo Road, Ruby Bay-Tasman** and known as "**The Tasman General Store**" to any person for consumption off the premises and to supply alcohol free, as a sample, for three months from **4 May 2020** and authorise the issue of the Order.

The applicant's attention is drawn to s.136 of the Act obliging the holder of the Order to:

1. Ensure that the off-licence remains in force for the term of the Order.
2. Comply with the same duties, obligations and liabilities as required by the current off-licence.
3. Comply with the conditions of the Order.
