



Additionally Regulation 39(a) of the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Regulations 2013 requires that the notice is in a place "where it can conveniently be read by a person outside the premises".

The posting of the public notice was undertaken on the applicant's letterbox on their property. The member of the public that initially objected to the renewal of this licence drew the Secretary's attention to the failure to strictly adhere to the statutory process with the public notice. However, the objection demonstrated that a member of the public with an interest in the renewal of this licence was able to become aware of the licence renewal being applied for. The applicant has requested a section 208 waiver to address the omission.

We consider that the omission is a matter of administrative neglect on the part of the applicant and was not wilful.

We waive the requirement to post the public notice in the precise manner defined in the Act. Additionally, we are satisfied as to the matters to which we must have regard as set out in s.131 of the Act and grant the application for a renewal of an off-licence pursuant to s.135 of the Act. The licence will expire on **24 April 2024** unless again renewed.
