Versions of our logo



Colour logo

This version is the preferred logo to be used when promoting Council.



Black logo

This version is for black and white (greyscale) usage.

Use supplied files only. Do not convert colour files to greyscale.



Negative logo

When used on a solid dark background, the negative version of the logo must be used

Preference is for use of a Tasman District Council coloured background.



Subtle toned image



Subtle toned image

Logo may sit on images but the image must be suitably subtle in contrast and not distract from the logo or make any parts of the logo unreadable.

Logo must not sit on a detailed image.

Use of the coloured logo on a similarly coloured/ non-complimentary coloured background.

Use of the reversed logo on either colour or black and white (greyscale) images that distract from the logo or make any parts of the logo unreadable.



Clearspace and Minimum Logo Size



Clearspace

The area marked x surrounding the logo must be kept clear regardless of the logo size.

X = the width of the 't' in the word 'tasman'.



Minimum logo size

The logo must not shrink below 30mm wide under any circumstances.

Resizing the logo



Horizontal + vertical





Horizontal stretch





Vertical stretch

Resizing proportionately

The logo must be resized proportionately at all times.

The logo must not be stretched horizontally or vertically to fit a space unless it is resized to scale.

ie. 200% horizontal must be 200% vertical.



File formats and colour systems

The Tasman District Council Master Logo Suite has been set up in a variety of formats that can be used in digital and print environments. Ensure that the correct file format is used in the correct environment.

File Formats

.eps

This format should be used whenever possible as it will give the best quality reproduction. This file format can be enlarged to any size without quality being compromised.

NOTE: No background has been applied to the white logo so that it can be used on images as well as the colour background.

.jpg and .png

These file formats are commonly used in Microsoft Office and digital environments that do not support .eps files. When using at large sizes quality may become compromised. These file formats should not be used for professional printing.

Colour Systems

CMYK

These files are to be used for print application only.

RGB

These files are to be used for Microsoft Office and digital applications.

PANTONE (Spot Colour)

These files are to be used for print application only.

LOGO Naming system

Logos will be named using a variety of the abbreviations below:

Abbreviations

SPOT – For print using spot colour: Pantone Blue 072 C. The C means Pantone recommended ink for printing on coated stock.

CMYK – For print using the four colour or digital process.

RGB – For print using Microsoft Office and for digital applications.

REV – Reversed.

BLK – Completely black logo.
