RM070807 Subdivision Consent	To subdivide, in three stages, two existing titles comprising 7.4 hectares into the following:
	 16 rural residential titles ranging between 2,120 square metres and 1.07 hectares (proposed Lots 1-16);
	 One title of 7,390 square metres being Road to vest in Tasman District Council (proposed Lot 17);
	 One title of 1,050 square metres being Local Purpose Reserve to vest in Tasman District Council (proposed Lot 18);
	 One title of 145 square metres being Local Purpose Reserve (Walkway) to vest in Tasman District Council (proposed Lot 19).
	A seven year lapsing period is being sought for the subdivision consent.
RM070808 Land Use Consent	To undertake the following activities associated with the subdivision described above (Application RM070807):
	• Construct a dwelling on each of proposed Lots 1-12 and Lots 14-16 (Lot 13 contains an existing dwelling), with a minimum setback of 5 metres from any boundary, and no minimum setback from water bodies on-site.

	• Construct dwellings on those allotments located within the Coastal Environment Area, all meeting the controlled activity criteria as set out in Rule 18.14.3 of the Proposed Tasman Resource Management Plan.
	• Land disturbance to: 1) fill the areas of the proposed building sites to a minimum level of RL 3.3 metres; 2) fill an unnamed tributary of the Moutere Inlet (locally known as Thorpe Drain); and 3) create roading on the subject site. A portion of these works would occur within 200 metres of the Coastal Marine Area (CMA).
	The application seeks, for the land use consent to construct dwellings, a lapsing period of five years from the date of the Section 223 survey plan approval being granted for the relevant stage of the subdivision. A 10 year lapsing period is being sought for the land disturbance component.
RM070809 Discharge Permit	To discharge stormwater from the subdivision described above (Application RM070807) to an unnamed tributary of the Moutere Inlet (locally known as Thorpe Drain).
	A 10 year lapsing period is being sought for the discharge permit.
RM070810 Water Permit	To divert water by way of realignment of an unnamed tributary of the Moutere Inlet (locally known as Thorpe Drain).
	A 10 year lapsing period is being sought for the water permit.
	The land is zoned Rural 1 and partly within the Coastal Environment Area in the Proposed Tasman Resource Management Plan.
	The application site is located at Old Wharf Road Motueka being legally described as Lots 2 and 3 DP 16330 (CT NL10C/812 and 11B/324)
