- RM040782 -The application seeks to subdivide an existing title of 1.7654 hectares into eight
residential allotments, with areas of between 1,030 square metres and 3,360
square metres. One of the proposed allotments (proposed Lot 7) contains an
existing dwelling. The application also includes the creation of the following
allotments:
 - 1. an Esplanade Reserve of 3,550 square metres to vest;
 - 2. a 1,500 square metre allotment as seabed to vest; and
 - 3. a 180 square metre allotment to vest as road.
- **RM060092 Land Use:** To erect a single dwelling on each of the proposed Lots 1-6 and 8 resulting from the subdivision outlined above.

The dwellings will be within the Coastal Environment Area under the Proposed Tasman Resource Management Plan.

The property is zoned Rural 2 under the Proposed Tasman Resource Management Plan.

The application site is located at Collingwood-Puponga Road, being legally described as Pt Section 4 Town of Seaford (CT NL8/19).
