The application seeks a subdivision consent to subdivide Lot 3 DP 304980 into two allotments. Proposed Lot 1 contains the existing dwelling and is 2.5981 hectares in area. Proposed Lot 2 is for rural residential purposes and is 1.4927 hectares in area. Access to Lot 1 and Lot 2 is proposed from Boyle Street. Also, sought is a land use consent to establish a dwelling on proposed Lot 2.

The property is zoned Rural 1 and the majority of the site is located within the Coastal Environment Area under the Proposed Tasman Resource Management Plan. The subdivision application constitutes a discretionary activity due to not meeting the 12 hectare net area prescribed for Rural 1 allotments. The land use application constitutes a discretionary activity as it is for a dwelling on a site of less than 12 hectares in the Rural 1 Zone.

The application site is located at the Corner of Lansdowne Street and Newman Street, Clifton being legally described as Lot 3 DP 304980 (Certificate of Title 20512)
