UPPER TAKAKA

This is an application made pursuant to Section 127 of the Resource Management Act 1991 to vary Condition 1 of Resource Consent NN020416 relating to the rate of take and the land irrigated. Condition 1 (NN020416) authorises the consent holder to take water from the Takaka River (at a location approximately 800 metres downstream of Lindsay's Bridge) at a rate of up to 103 litres per second (8,900 cubic metres per day). This application seeks to increase the rate of take by 17 litres per second (1,469 cubic metres per day) to enable irrigation of an additional 30 hectares of pasture located west of Uruwhenua Road.
