Restoration work on buildings identified as having heritage value and listed in Schedule 16.13A of the Council's Tasman Resource Management Plan will be eligible to be considered for a financial contribution from the Council.

Options





If Repainting: A contribution of \$200 towards repainting.

OR

If Repiling, Reroofing, Replacing Guttering or Earthquake Strengthening: A contribution of up to \$500 towards repiling, reroofing, replacement or guttering, and up to \$500 for earthquake strengthening (for works less than \$100,000) <u>or</u> \$1000 (for works of \$100,000 or more).

To be considered to receive this funding, please complete the application form overleaf and post it to Council. Please apply before work begins and payment will be made on completion of approved work and provision of receipts.
