1 SPARC Rural Travel Fund

2 COMMUNITY GRANTS

2.1 Epilepsy Foundation of New Zealand

An application had been received from Epilepsy Foundation of New Zealand for sponsorship of children to attend a film party.

It was decided the application was outside the rules of community grants.

2.2 Nelson Tasman Business Trust

An application had been received for \$10,000 from Nelson Tasman Business Trust, for business mentoring services.

The Subcommittee agreed to grant \$4,000 and ask for more specific information regarding client base and outcomes for the Tasman District portion, eg Motueka, Golden Bay, Lakes/Murchison and Richmond, when considering any future application.

2.3 Wakatu Incorporation

An application was received under the Arts, Culture, Heritage category for \$500 towards the publishing costs of Te Ara Hou: The New Society.
