4.1 Operatunity Class Act Opera

Decline and refer to small grants through Arts Council. Under-developed application.

4.2 Plunket Richmond Young Mum's Group

Decline. Not high enough priority. Refer them to Arts Council Nelson for discretionary grant.

4.3 Golden Bay Tennis Club

Had money from grants from rates so only require \$500 for project. Chris Finlayson has done designs for a painted mural at the Pohara Clubrooms. The mural will be done by children with Chris Finlayson. \$500 approved.

4.4 Stage Challenge Foundation

Decline. Not high enough priority.

4.5 Golden Bay Heritage Aorere Trust

Decline. Ineligible for funding from Creative Communities.

4.6 CEEDS

Sculpture workshops, music. For PA hire and person to set up and run it for ten performances in Golden Bay. Received \$1,500 from grants from rates for Heart Art festival. Mr Knowles needs guidance on allocation limits – \$1,200 for creative communities funding. \$800 approved.

4.7 Golden Bay Community Board

Artists had done good quality banners at no cost for part of Commercial Street. The application is to do banners for all of Commercial Street, Motupipi Street and Collingwood. Received \$1,000 from grants for rates for brackets. \$1,000 approved.

4.8 Nelson Symphony Orchestra

Decline. Not high enough priority.

4.9 Dramatix Theatre Development Trust

Promotion and inclusion of wider region and ability to work in with other dawn parades. Contact M Tasman-Jones for help. \$650 approved.
