117 of the 327 dog barking complaints during the period April - Sep 2009 were from one person, which had inflated the figures.

It was suggested that people registering dogs in the Golden Bay area were notified at the time of registration that there was a bylaw in place prohibiting dogs on Commercial Street, Takaka.

A discussion ensued regarding freedom camping and the problems associated with managing this issue.

It was however, beyond the conditions of the Resource Consent.

Staff advised that contractors held regular meetings with the public and iwi to answer questions and deal with any complaints received.

Councillors requested that a turning bay currently being used by the school bus along Old Coach Road be retained. Mr Shaw advised that he would speak with the Transportation Manager Mr Clark and provide a response at a later meeting.
