1. Welcome

The Chair welcomed everyone to the meeting.

3. Minutes of the previous meeting – 12 December 2018

The minutes of the meeting held on 12 December 2018 were confirmed as a true and correct record.

4. Action items from the previous meeting

The action list was updated.

5. Operations and safety issues

- Concern was raised regarding helicopter operation adjacent to parachute landing area.
 S Bean explained safety procedure to mitigate risk.
- Giles Witney raised concern about the power poles encroaching the Obstacle
 Limitation Surface at the south end of the runway and Councils operational
 responsibility once identified. The exemptions under the TRMP were discussed and it
 was agreed Andrew Ellis / Jane Park would go back to Network Tasman to get costings
 to have the power poles removed.
- Rubber build up on runway markings discussed. Committee agreed NDRA be approached about repainting over the rubber and maintenance.
- The Committee is in favour of renewing the NDRA licence.
- Concern was raised regarding the fuel running out the previous week. A NOTAM
 (notice to airmen) issued. G Witney requested TDC purchase tanker for future fuel
 shortage. Giles Witney requested TDC purchase tanker for future fuel shortage.
- The Committee agreed this was not TDC responsibility.

6. Fees and Charges 2019/2020

2019/20 proposed fees and charges were circulated for discussion. Andrew Ellis explained the process and timeframe to have the fees confirmed.



Some felt the annual recreational charge was too high.

Comment was made about the increase to helicopter landing fee. It was explained that the fee was not limited to runway maintenance but aerodrome maintenance so all users should contribute.

A CPI increase was suggested but as many of the fees were new and there was still regular use of the honesty box a 'round' figure was the preference.

The short term parking fee was not endorsed by the committee and there was consensus to remove this charge.

7. General Business
