**SUBJECT:** Facilities Rate Financial Statement and Projection

This report is prepared to give guidance to the Subcommittee on the anticipated balance of the Community Facilities Rates account at 30 June 2007 and 30 June 2008, together with the value of loans currently being serviced by this account. The report also identifies budgeted movements through the account during the two operational years ending June 2008.

In its LTCCP and draft 2007/2008 Annual Plan, Council has identified a number of projects to be funded by either the District Facilities Rate or Regional Facilities Rate. The impact of these projects on the balance of the Facilities Rate account during these two years will be as follows:
