**SUBJECT:** Trading in Streets and Public Places Bylaw

## **PURPOSE**

The purpose of this report is to recommend to the Tasman District Council to adopt the reviewed and amended Consolidated Bylaw – Chapter 6 – Trading in Streets and Public Places.

## **BACKGROUND**

As required by the Local Government Act, the above Bylaw was reviewed and the Special Consultation Process undertaken, with public hearings of the submissions made. The Environment and Planning Subcommittee then recommended by Resolution EP05/06/44 that Council adopts the revised Trading in Streets and Public Places Bylaw with the following amendments:

- (a) in Clause 6.3 delete the word "place" and substitute the word "road";
- (b) incorporate the changes recommended by the Council solicitor;
- (c) incorporate a definition of "road" as suggested by Transit New Zealand;
- (d) add to Clause 6.1 (siting restrictions) the Waikoropupu Springs road and car park.

## **RECOMMENDATION**

It is hereby recommended that the Tasman District Council:

- (a) adopt the draft March 2005 Consolidated Bylaw Chapter 6 Trading in Streets and Public Places as amended; and
- (b) adopt the commencement date of the Bylaw coming into force on the 30<sup>th</sup> day of June 2005; and
- (c) repeal the Tasman District Council Trading in Streets and Public Places Bylaw No. 1 (1994).
