Regional Land Transport Committee

The RLTC means a Standing Committee of the Regional Council established under Section 178 of the Land Transport Act 1998. A function of the RLTC is to prepare the Regional Land Transport Strategy for approval by the Regional Council (obviously Tasman District Council and Nelson City Council are unitary authorities).

Under the Act it is directed that each RLTC should consist of suitable persons appointed by the relevant regional council to represent:

- The objectives of economic development, safety and personal security, public health, access and mobility, and environmental sustainability; and
- Cultural interests: and
- The council; and
- Other territorial authorities in the region; and
- The Authority; and
- Transfund

Current membership of the Nelson-Tasman RLTC includes representatives from:

- The two Councils (two from each Council);
- Transit New Zealand:
- Land Transport New Zealand;
- The Road Transport Association
- New Zealand Police;
- The Automobile Association;
- Community Health;
- The Nelson Economic Development Agency;
- Cycle users; and
- Total Mobility.
