PURPOSE OF THE REPORT

The purpose of this report is to ask the Council to approve the final Activity Management Plans for:

- Transportation
- Rivers
- Water Supply
- Stormwater
- Wastewater
- Solid Waste
- Aerodromes, and
- Coastal Structures

and to seek Council's agreement for the documents to be publicly released via the website and Tasman District Council Libraries.

COMMENT

The Engineering infrastructure Activity Management Plans underpin the work programmes and financial modelling in the Ten Year Plan and these final copies have been edited to reflect and be consistent with the Ten Year Plan.

During the Ten Year Planning process, some members of the public indicated that they would like further detail than is available in the Ten Year Plan on the Council work programmes and costs of various projects that Council is proposing to do over the next ten years. Most of the detail sought is contained in the Activity Management Plans. Therefore, making the Plans available to the public will meet these needs.

A further advantage of making the Plans available is that they provide the public with an indication of the projects the Council has planned over the next 20 years, compared to the ten years covered in the Ten Year Plan.
