During The Month...

The Tasman District Council prepared a submission on the proposal for the union of Nelson City and Tasman District. Dates have been set for hearings of submissions (A schedule is attached). The Tasman District Council submission will be heard on 15 December in the morning here at the Council Chambers. A separate report in this agenda covers the planned verbal presentation on the Tasman District Council submission.

The Tasman District Council 2009-2010 Annual Report has been published and is available on the Tasman District Council website.

Tasman District Council has submitted on the Law Commission review of the Local Government Official Information and Meetings Act and Official Information Act; and supported the Local Government New Zealand submission on the Marine and Coastal Area Bill.

Auckland Supercity has got underway with large changes in staffing and elected members. The Minister of Local Government, Hon Rodney Hide, has indicated that he will now turn his attention to reforms for the remainder of the country's Local Government sector. He has indicated this may focus on how central government can better work with, and support, local government.

The Alcohol Law Reform package has been released by Parliament

Nelson Bays Community Trust

The Nelson Bays Community Trust is a very worthy organisation and we appreciate the work they do in the community. Cr Edgar has previously been the Council representative Trustee. With the commencement of the new term of Council she is no longer the Tasman District Council Trustee and is not obliged to continue as a Trustee. I acknowledge the increased workload for Cr Edgar as Chair of Community Services Committee, in addition to the work she does in the community. I therefore will ask at the Council meeting if anyone else would like to be a Trustee and if there are no volunteers, we will note that there is no nominated Council Trustee.

Citizenship Ceremonies

Follow a discussion between Murray Staite, and the two Committee secretaries and myself, I propose citizenship ceremonies take place at 9.30am on the morning of Full Council four times per year in Richmond, and once every 8 months in Takaka, dependant on the number of persons put forward by the Department of Internal Affairs for citizenship.

While the Citizenship ceremonies will commence at 9.30am it would be highly desirable to have a good presence of Councillors to demonstrate our support for new citizens to our District.

I would also like to see a cultural element included in the ceremonies.
