SUBJECT: Regional Projects/Community Projects

INTRODUCTION

At the Subcommittee meeting of 5 August 2005 staff were requested to prepare a report assessing their current projects would sit within either a regional facilities rate or a community facilities rate.

Council currently levies a rate of \$35.00 per property for community facilities and a rate of \$8.40 per property specifically to provide funding for the district museum loan.

DISCUSSION

In undertaking a financial assessment of a perceived community rate or regional rate we are required first to determine how a project would be categorised as either "community" or "regional".

A reasonable starting point would be to consider the primary funding source for these projects. In other words, if major funding for a project is provided from the regional facilities fund the project could then clearly be considered to be a "regional project". On the other hand those projects whose 80% funding source is exclusively from Tasman District Council and whose 20% local share is primarily sourced from the local community of interest, the project could then be deemed to be a community project.

Looking at those projects that Council has either funded to date or has resolved to provide funding for, we would then classify as follows:
