PURPOSE/REASON FOR REPORT

To update the Community Services Committee on the status of the Collingwood Trafalgar Society.

BACKGROUND

The Collingwood Trafalgar Society was established to co-ordinate the bi-centenary of the Battle of Trafalgar, which was commemorated in Collingwood and Nelson in October 2005. The programme in Collingwood consisted of a Heritage Day and Township Day, as well as a spectacular fireworks display over Aorere, and all the events were well attended by locals and visitors

Funding for the bi-centennial in Collingwood was primarily from the TDC Grants from Rates, with additional funding from Pub Charity and sponsorship for the fireworks from Sealord Group Ltd.
