RURAL FIRE FORCES

I attended the Annual General Meeting of the Appleby Volunteer Rural Fire Force on Friday 27 July and the following are some of the points out of this meeting:

- Currently there are 16 members.
- 79 callouts (up 6 from the previous year).
- Of these 79, 14 were motor vehicle accidents, 21 vegetation fires, 5 car fires, 4 structure fires, 11 false alarms plus a number of miscellaneous incidents.
- Out of the 79 callouts, 57 were attended with Richmond, 16 with Upper Moutere, 3 with Mapua, 2 with Wakefield and 1 with Stoke.

The following are some of the main points from the recent Ngatimoti Rural Fire Force Annual General Meeting:

- 17 callouts 3 structures, 6 vehicles, 8 vegetation.
- Opened their new fire station and community room.
- Other activities included training day at Rabbit Island, assisted in burnoffs and two members attended a 4 wheel drive course.
