The attached applications have been received for the October 2007 SPARC Rural Travel Fund.

#### BACKGROUND

The fund is targeted at the travel costs of young people aged between 5-19 years participating in regular local sport teams' competition. The allocation of the fund is based on a population density formula for territorial authorities whom have less than 10 people per square kilometre. Tasman's allocation is \$17,571 for the 2007/2008 year. There are two rounds per year with the next closing end of April. There is a total of \$8,785.50 available for the October round.

### RURAL TRAVEL FUND ELIGIBILITIES

The following criteria shall be applied when considering applications for funding.

"A school club team participating in local sport competition in weekends, that excludes inter school and intra school competitions played during school time"; and/or "a sports club team participating in organised sport competition through club membership outside of school time".

Please note: The rural travel fund should not be provided for the purpose of travel to oneoff regional or national events.
