# RICHMOND

Site	Projects for 2007/08	Timeframe
Jubilee Park	Irrigation	Work to commence in September
Sandeman Reserve	Planting	A planting is to be held on the reserve on 16/08/08 with MWH staff. MWH is also making a financial contribution to this project.

### **MOUTERE – WAIMEA**

Site	Projects for 2007/08	Timeframe
Aranui Park	Pond development	The hard landscaping work has been completed, work is continuing on the soft landscaping and tree work.
Mapua Recreation Reserve	Path and Vehicle Barrier	A gravel path is to be put in to link Iwa Street with the village mall. Vehicle barriers are to be installed to keep cars etc off the Sportsfields and the root zone of the large trees.
Coach Place Reserve	New Swing	A swing suitable for mobility impaired children has been installed in the reserve.
Shuttleworth Reserve	Playground	A site meeting has been held with local residents to discuss the site and design of the playground. Plans are being developed for the site.

Two Rivers Walkway	Planting	A planting is to be held on the walkway river berm on 9/08/08. This years Honda funding will be used to finance this project.
Faulkner Bush Reserve	Planting	A planting will be held in this reserve on 9/08/08.
Kina Reserve	Maintenance work	Post and rope fences and sand ladders are to be installed in the reserve to help prevent pedestrian erosion of the coastal frontage. Tree work is also being carried out in the reserve.
McKee Recreation Reserve	Maintenance work	Post and rope fences and sand ladders are to be installed at this reserve to help prevent pedestrian erosion of the coastal frontage.
Rabbit Island	Shade sails	Two new shade sail areas will be installed in the reserve funded from the sale of timber from the reserve area (Jacks picnic area).
