Kina Reserve	Tree Issues (Steve)	Consultation is underway with neighbours regarding views and the need to carry out tree work.
Appleby Hills Development	Walkway (Glenn)	The walkway development is underway and shaping up very nicely.
Pinehill Road	Walkway (Glenn)	A site meeting has been held with adjoining neighbours and the contractor who will be carrying out the work.
