5. REGIONAL

A number of compliments have been received about how beautiful Washbourn Gardens are looking at the moment.

This year's winter planting programme has been completed with around 30,000 native trees and shrubs along with 10,000 coastal grasses and rear dune species being planted at various sites around the district.

The New Zealand Recreation Association, along with assistance from Tasman District Council and Nelson City Council staff, hosted a one day Cemetery Seminar in Tasman/Nelson which included site visits to Motueka and Marsden Valley Cemeteries. Twenty Council staff and contractors from cemeteries around the country attended and all were very complimentary about our area.

Staff have been busy completing the Activity Management Plans and Ten Year budgets.
