SUBJECT: **Mobile Scooter (“Pram”) Ramps – RMCB11-03-01**

PURPOSE

To clarify the funding source for mobile scooter (“pram”) ramps.

BACKGROUND

The Motueka Community Board at its meeting on 15 June 2010 resolved as follows:

MCB10-06-08***

THAT the Motueka Community Board requests the Engineering Services Department of Tasman District Council to construct a minimum of six mobile scooter (“pram”) ramps during 2010 – 2011, and that a further six ramps be constructed during 2010 – 2011, if funding allows, but no later than 2011 – 2012.

CARRIED”

The resolution did not include the funding source for these ramps.

DISCUSSION

It is proposed that the funding of \$15,000 comes from the Motueka Community Board’s budget surplus.

SIGNIFICANCE

This matter is not significant in terms of Council’s Significance Policy.

RECOMMENDATION

THAT the Motueka Community Board requests the Engineering Services Department of Tasman District Council to construct a minimum of six mobile scooter (“pram”) ramps during 2010 – 2011, and that a further six ramps be

constructed during 2010 – 2011, if funding allows, but no later than 2011 – 2012, to a maximum of \$15,000, with the funding coming from the Motueka Community Board’s budget surplus.
