PROJECT	STATUS
Walkways	Keep Motueka Beautiful are continuing to work on the Estuary (ex sawmill site) walkway.
Memorial Park	Work has started on the car park formation for the Senior Net and Toy Library building.
Decks Reserve Toilet Upgrade	Work is underway on the upgrade and is expected to be completed on 17 th August.
Decks Reserve path/planting	Glenn Thorn is working on a plan for the extension of the footpath and further planting for the reserve.
Thorp Bush New Toilet	Awaiting the delivery of replacement parts for those that were damaged in transit.
Motueka Cemetery	The Arbour Day plantings went really well. The pine tree area has been mown and will now be sown in grass.
Brooklyn Reserve/ Riwaka Memorial Reserve	Arbour Day plantings were undertaken on these reserves and look really good.
The Harbour Board land on Wharf Road	This area has been mown with a mulching mower and is ready for grass seed and planting.
Trewavas Street Foreshore Reserve	Louise Clives has been working with local residents on a project on the reserve which has entailed removing some pampas and old tree Lucerne and replanting with natives.
Tree Vandalism	We have had three large mature ngaio trees along with a patch of young natives cut down at Little Kaiteriteri Reserve, this has been reported to the police and an article will be going into the local papers. Young trees in the Hickmott Car park have also been vandalised and will be replaced.
